





The 3 Imperatives Mini Self-Assessment

- 1. I avoid the traps of **authority** and **friendship**.
- 2. People trust me.
- 3. I proactively build and maintain **relationships** with those who my team depends on.
- 4. I actively help others in my networks to achieve their goals.
- 5. My **team** is capable of learning and adapting together.
- 6. I deal with individual and team performance issues quickly.

- Become self-aware and build emotional connections with others
- Build trust
- Share authority often and generously
- Become a powerful advocate for your team



Manage YOUR NETWORK



- Understand how your organization really works
- Avoid being a powerless boss
- Expand your web of influence
- Create a powerful coalition with your boss

- Align your team with your organization's purpose


